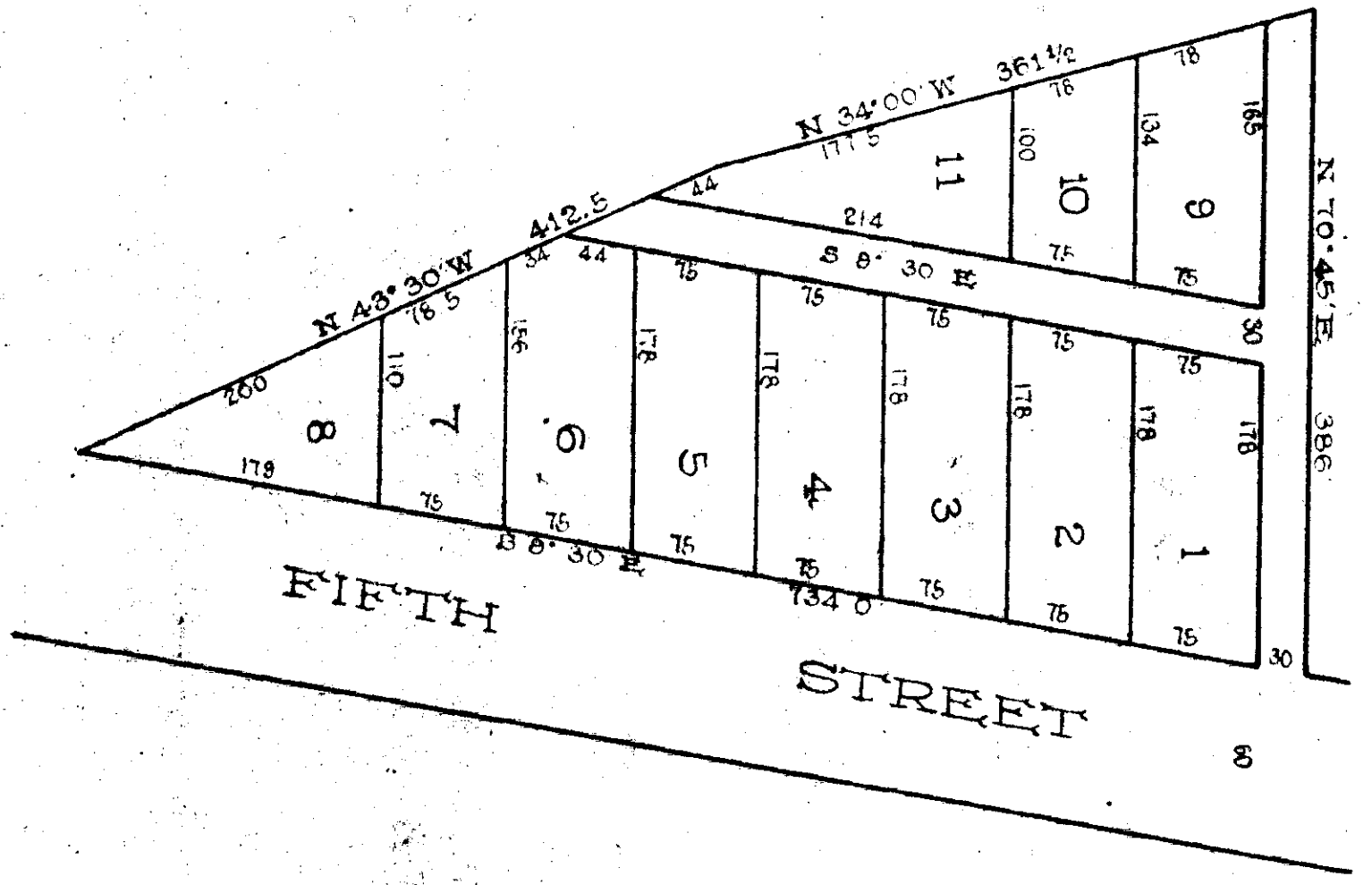
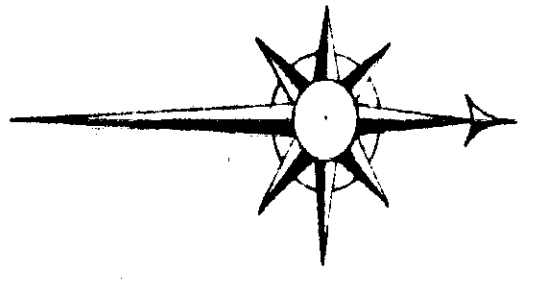


LIDDELL AND HERZBERG
