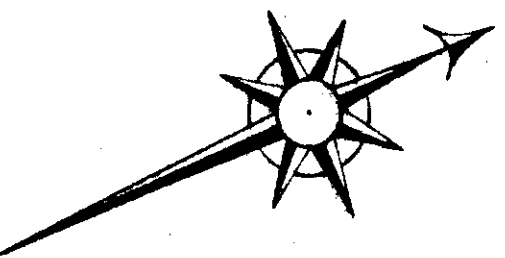


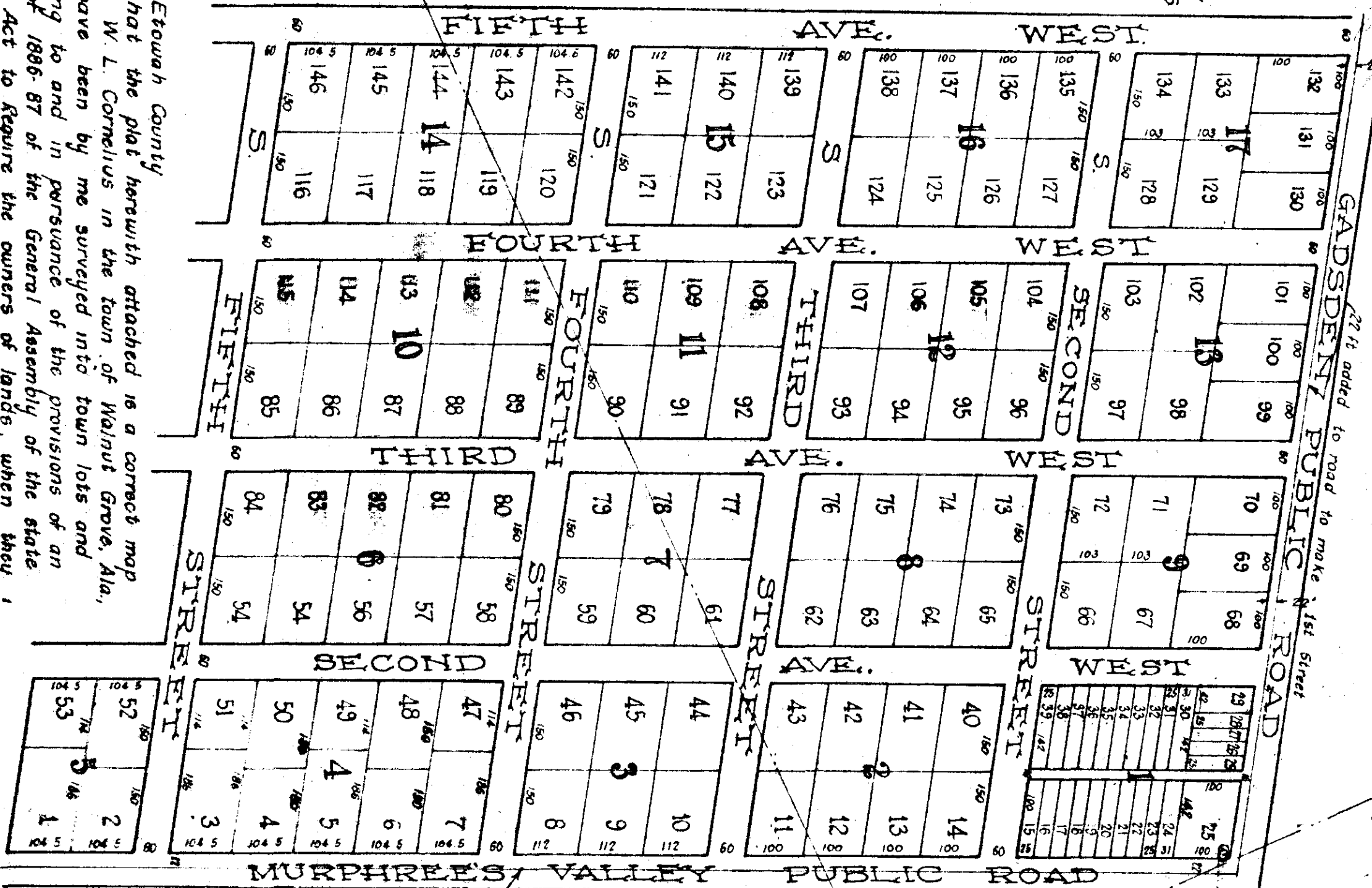
W. L. CORNELIUS PLAT
