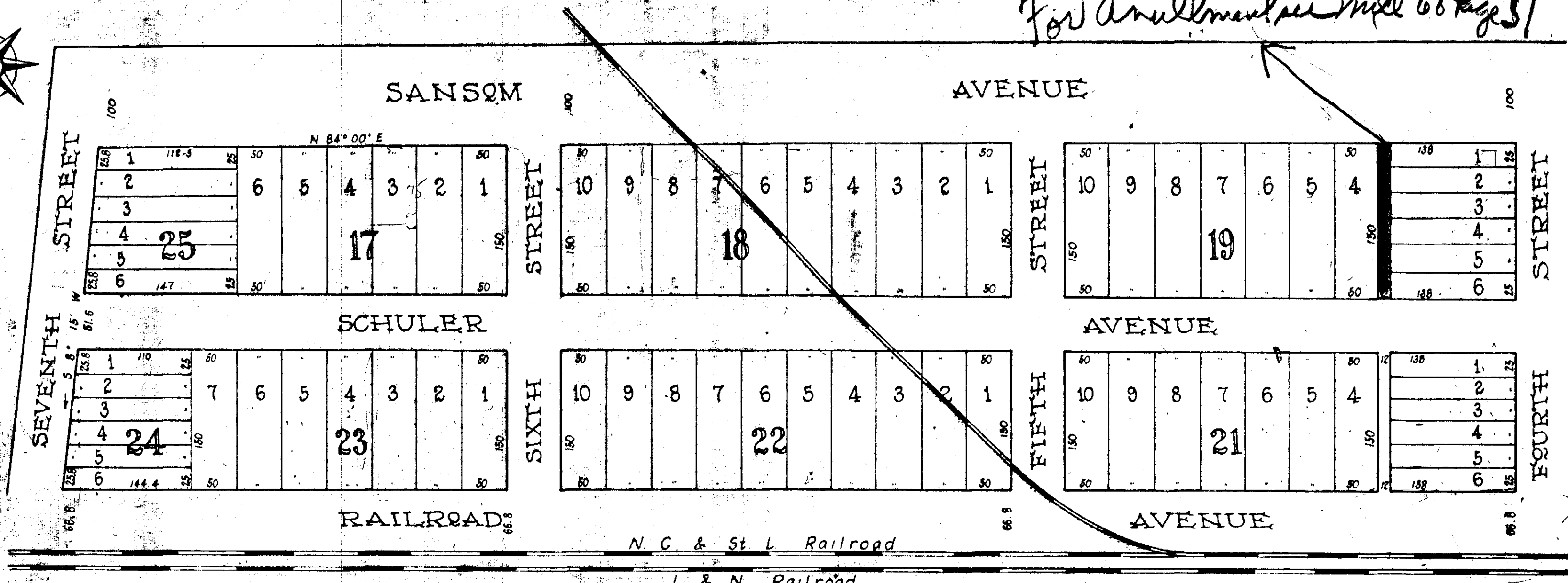
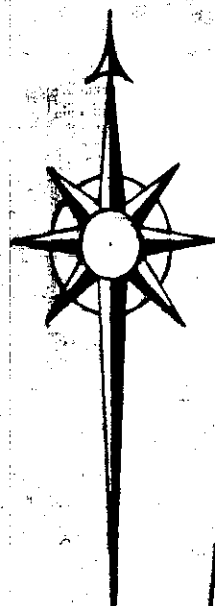


RE-SURVEY OF R. B. KYLE'S PROPERTY
