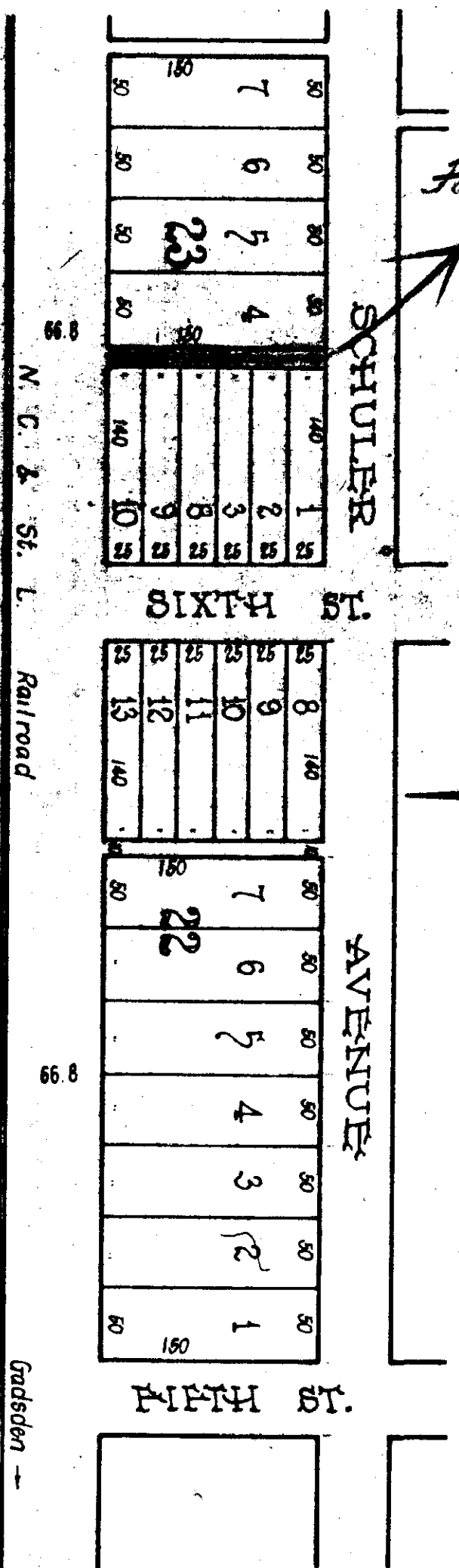
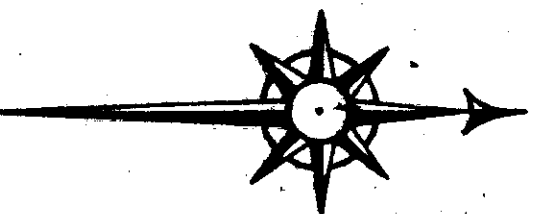


COOSA LAND CO.'S REARRANGEMENT
