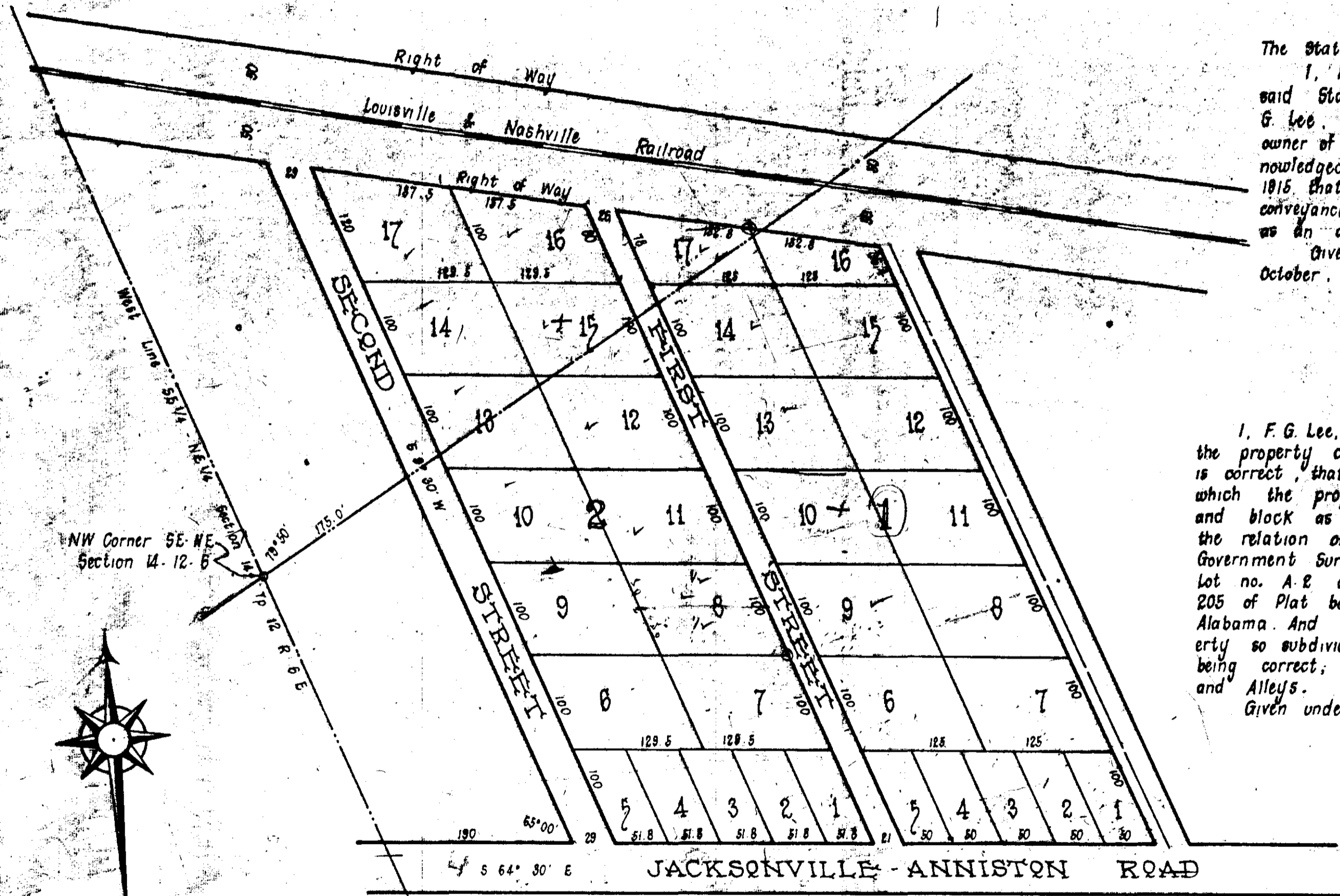


W. M. SMITH'S 2ND ADDITION
