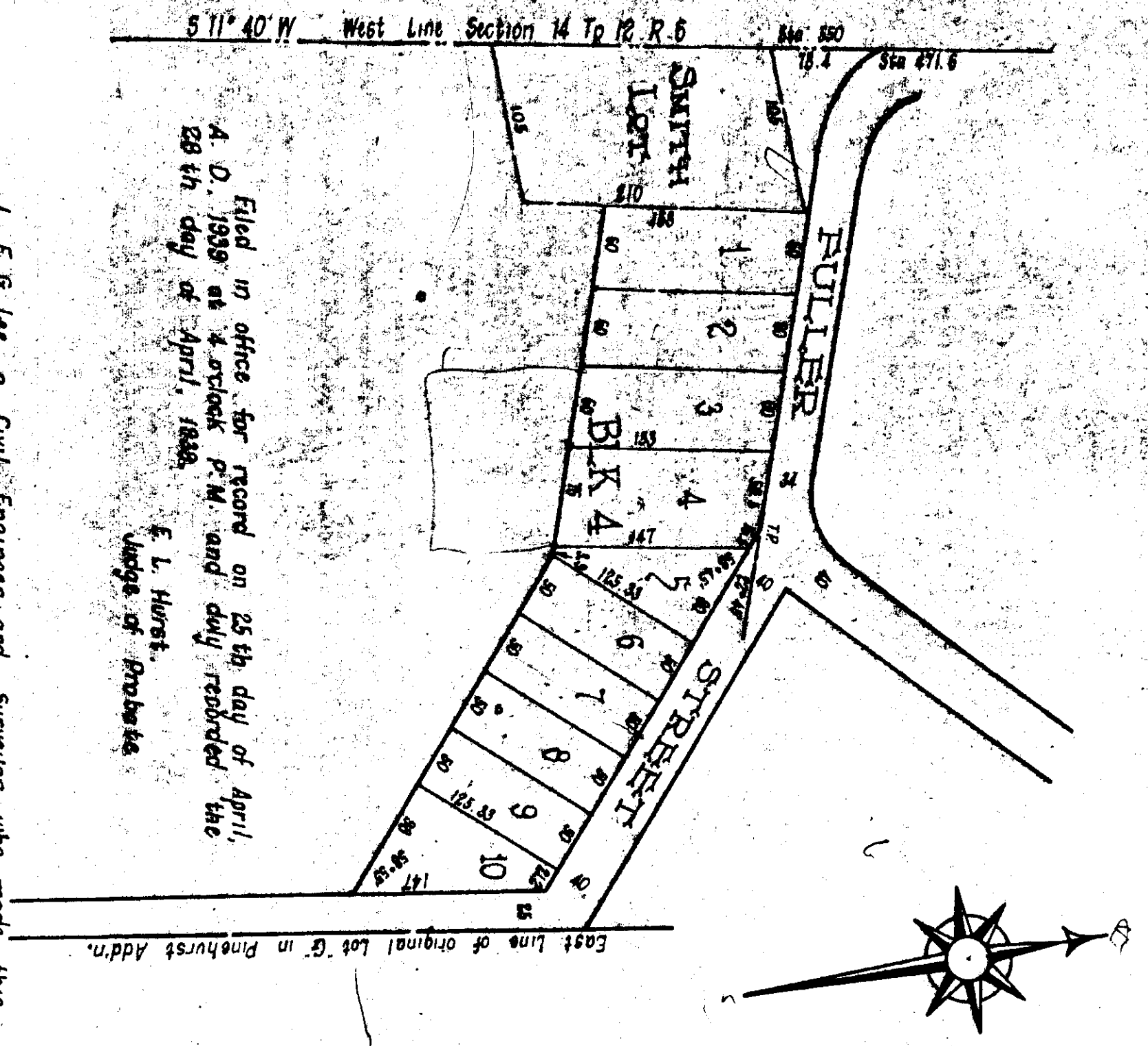


# REARRANGEMENT BLOCK 4 COLLEGE HEIGHTS
