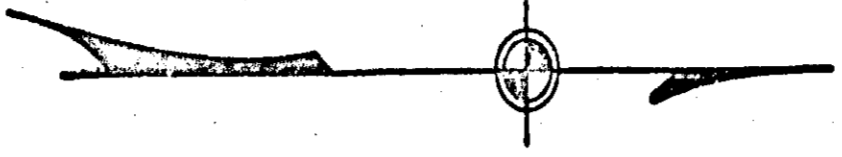


MAP OF
