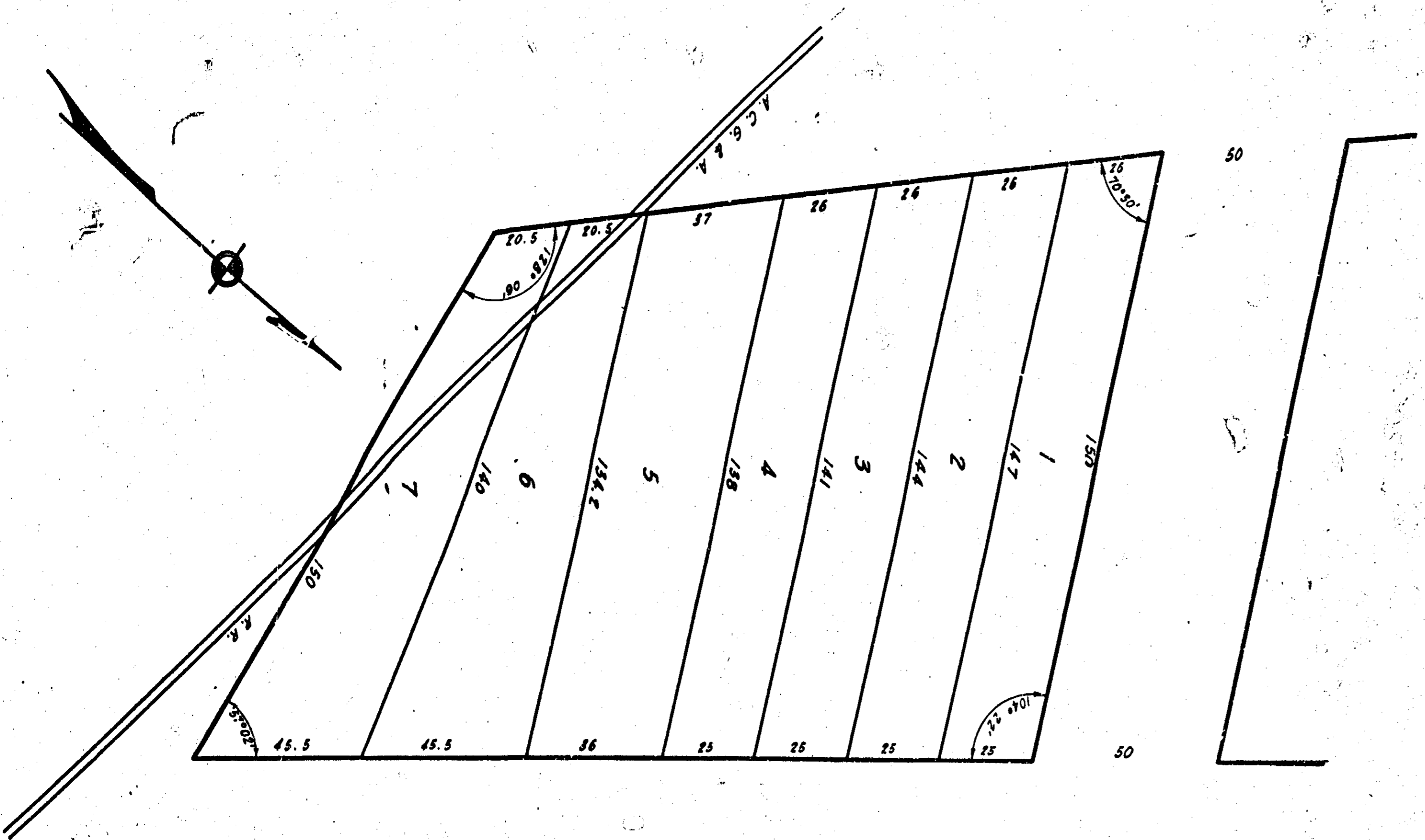


MAP OF
