I, Ernest Smith, a Surveyor, hereby certify that I surveyed the lands embraced in this map, the bearings, lengths, widths of each Street, lots and blocks as shown thereon, that the bearings, lengths, widths of each Street as stated in said map or plat are correct as shown thereon, and that the relation of the land so platted or mapped to the Government Survey is correctly stated and shown in the map or plat. The undersigned, The Goddsden Land Co. dedicates to public use the Streets, Avenues, and Alleys as shown by the map or plat, subject to the rights, easements and privileges heretofore conveyed by the Coosa Land Co. by deed of date Oct 4, 1909 to the Goddsden Railway Co. the undersigned Goddsden Land Co. having obtained title to the lands embraced in the map or plat from the Coosa Land Company subject to said rights, franchises, and privileges, heretofore granted and conveyed to said Goddsden Railway Company, said rights, franchises, and privileges consisting of strips of land 20 feet wide in the center of each Street and Avenue for the construction and maintenance of Street Railways, of erecting poles and appliances, and stretching wires on and along the Streets, Avenues and Alleys for the purpose of transmitting electric currents, of laying pipes and conduits in said Streets, Avenues and Alleys, for placing wires and other appliances for the transmission of electric currents, also of erecting poles and stretching wires on or along the Streets, Avenues, and Alleys for Telephone and Telegraphic services.
