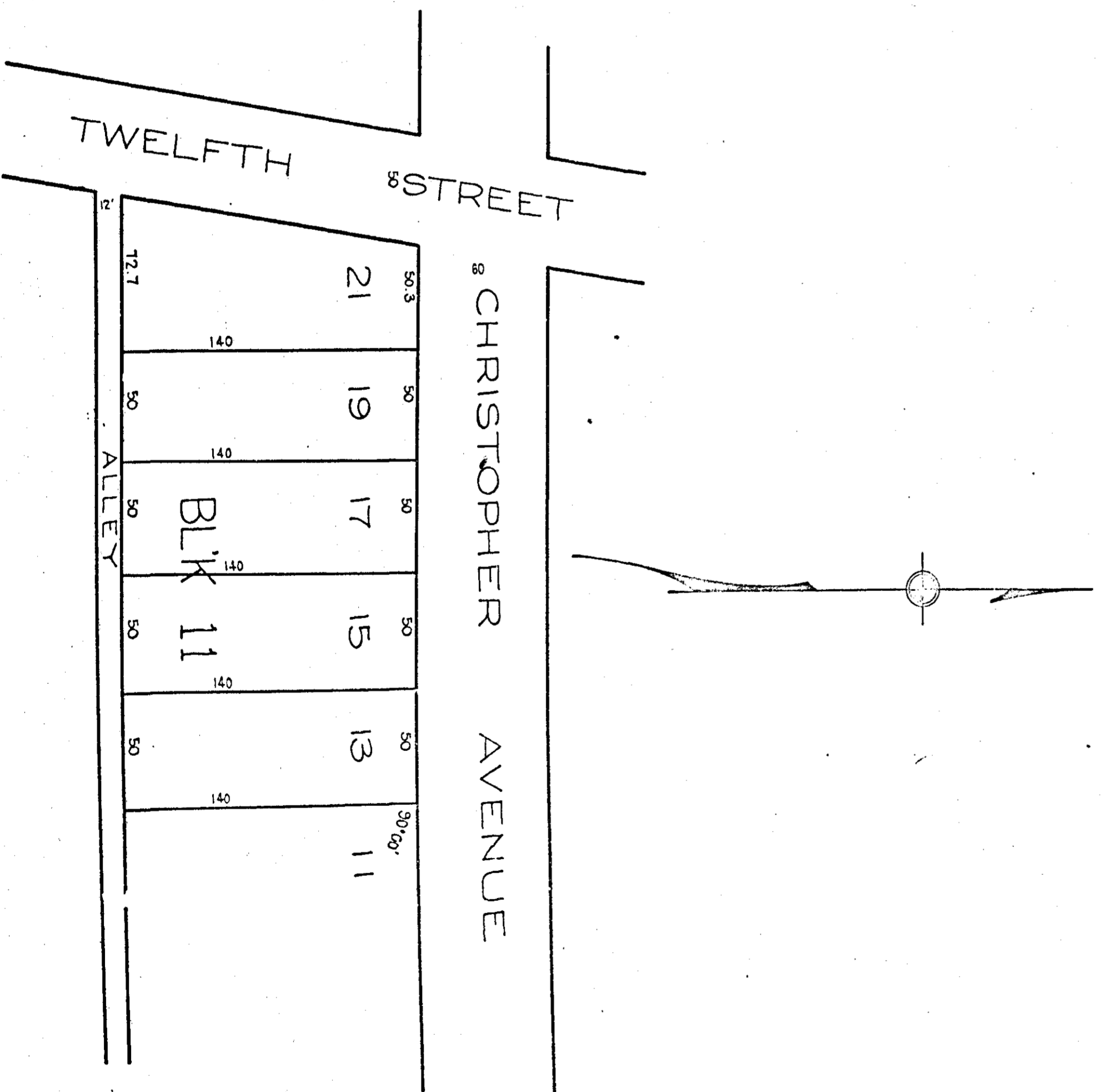


REARRANGMENT OF A PART
