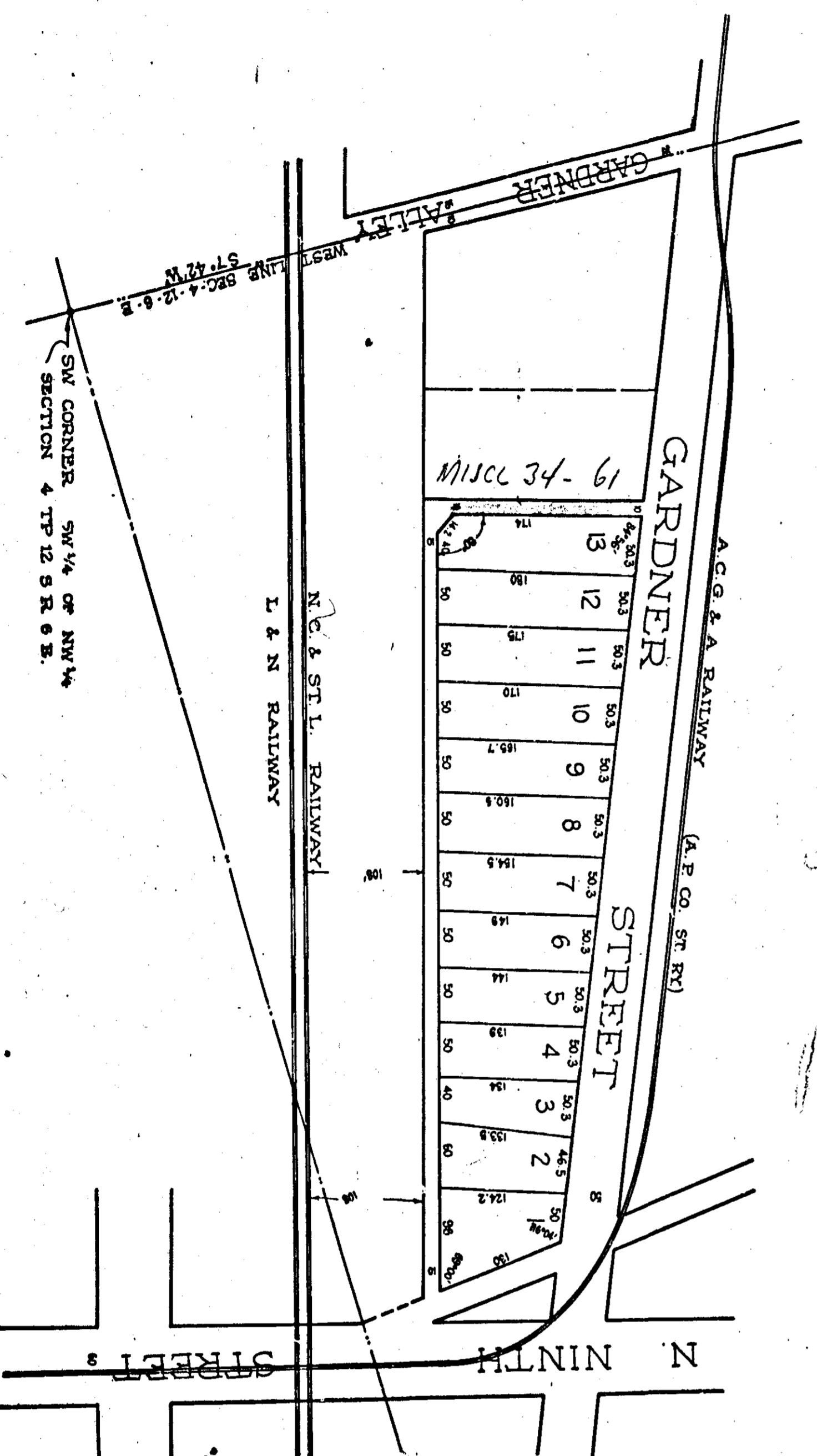


MAP OF
