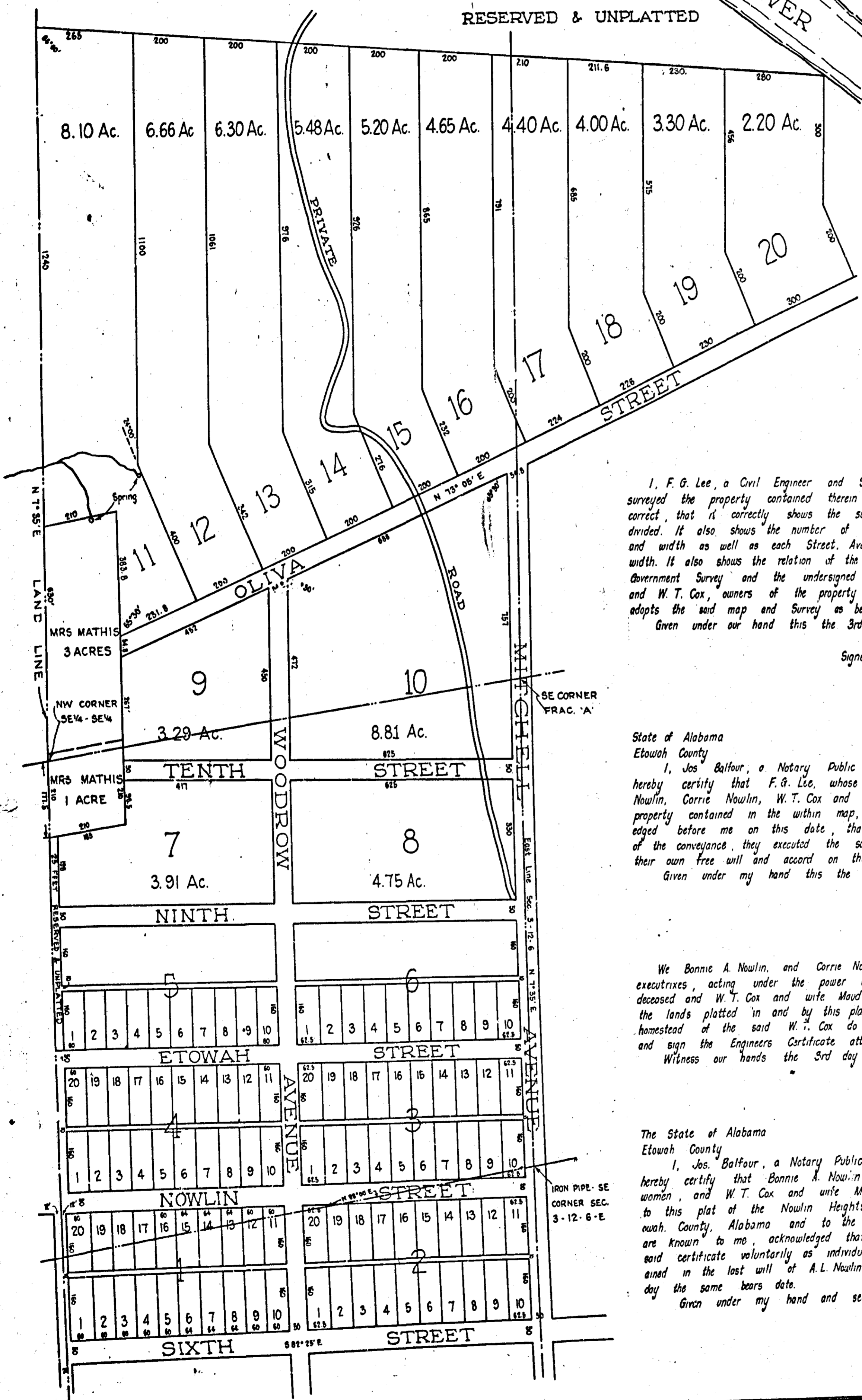
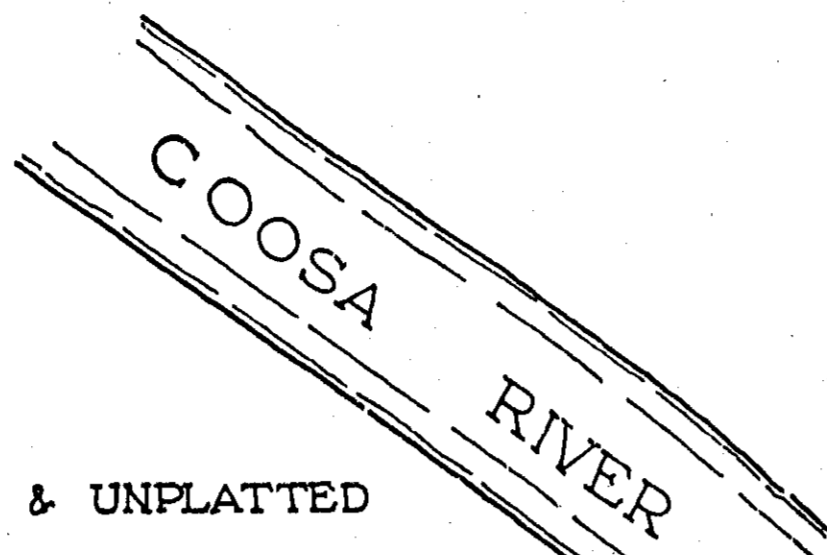


MAP OF
