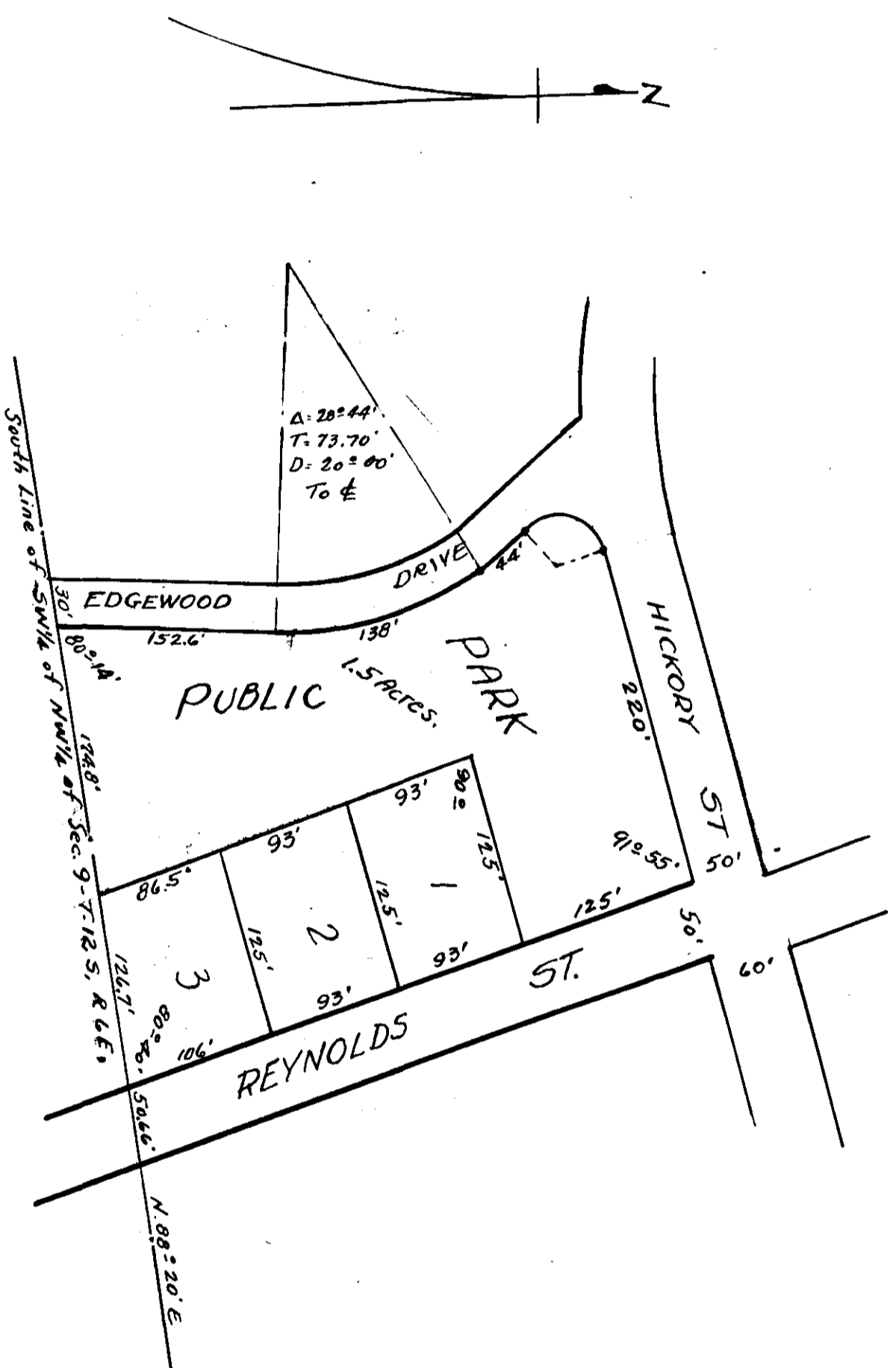


MAP OF
