

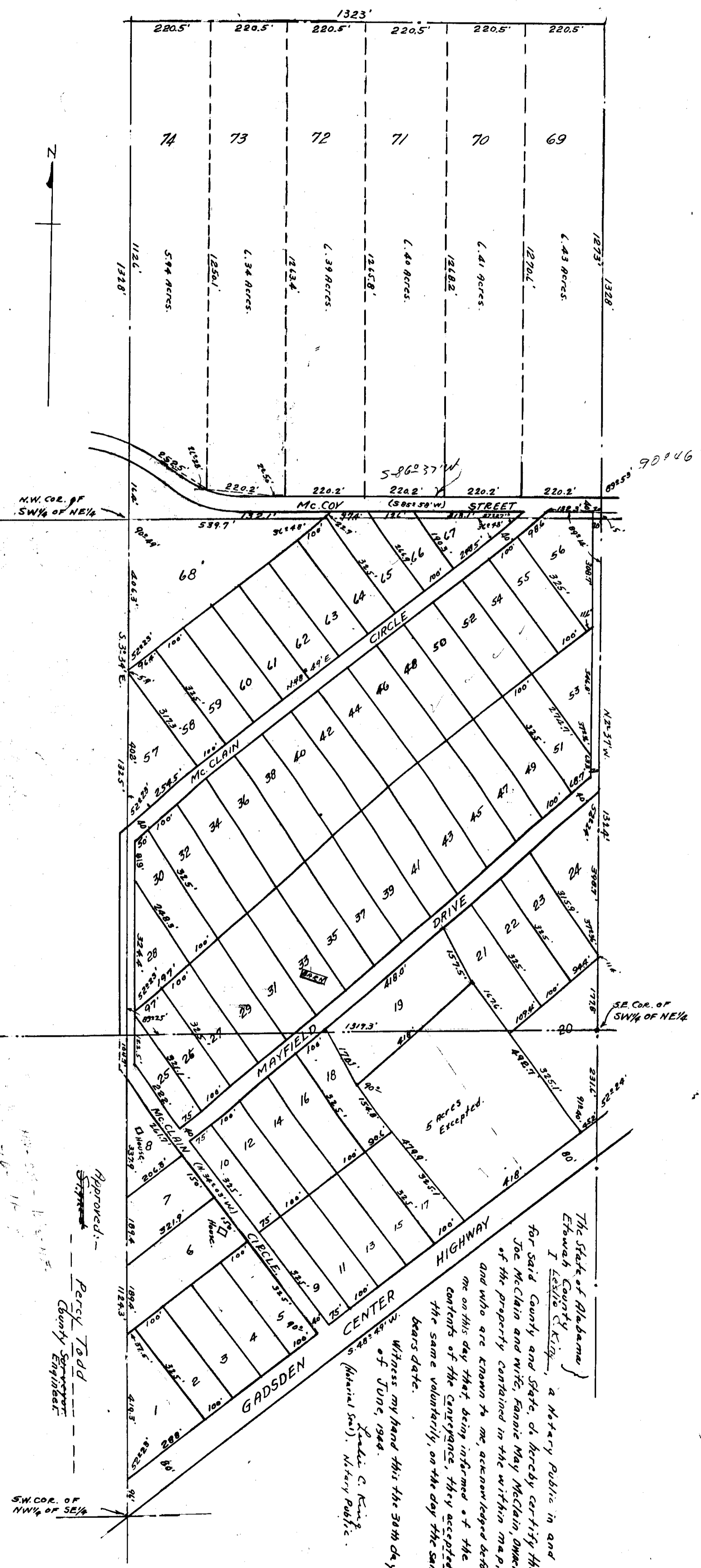
MAP OF MCCLAIN HEIGHTS
