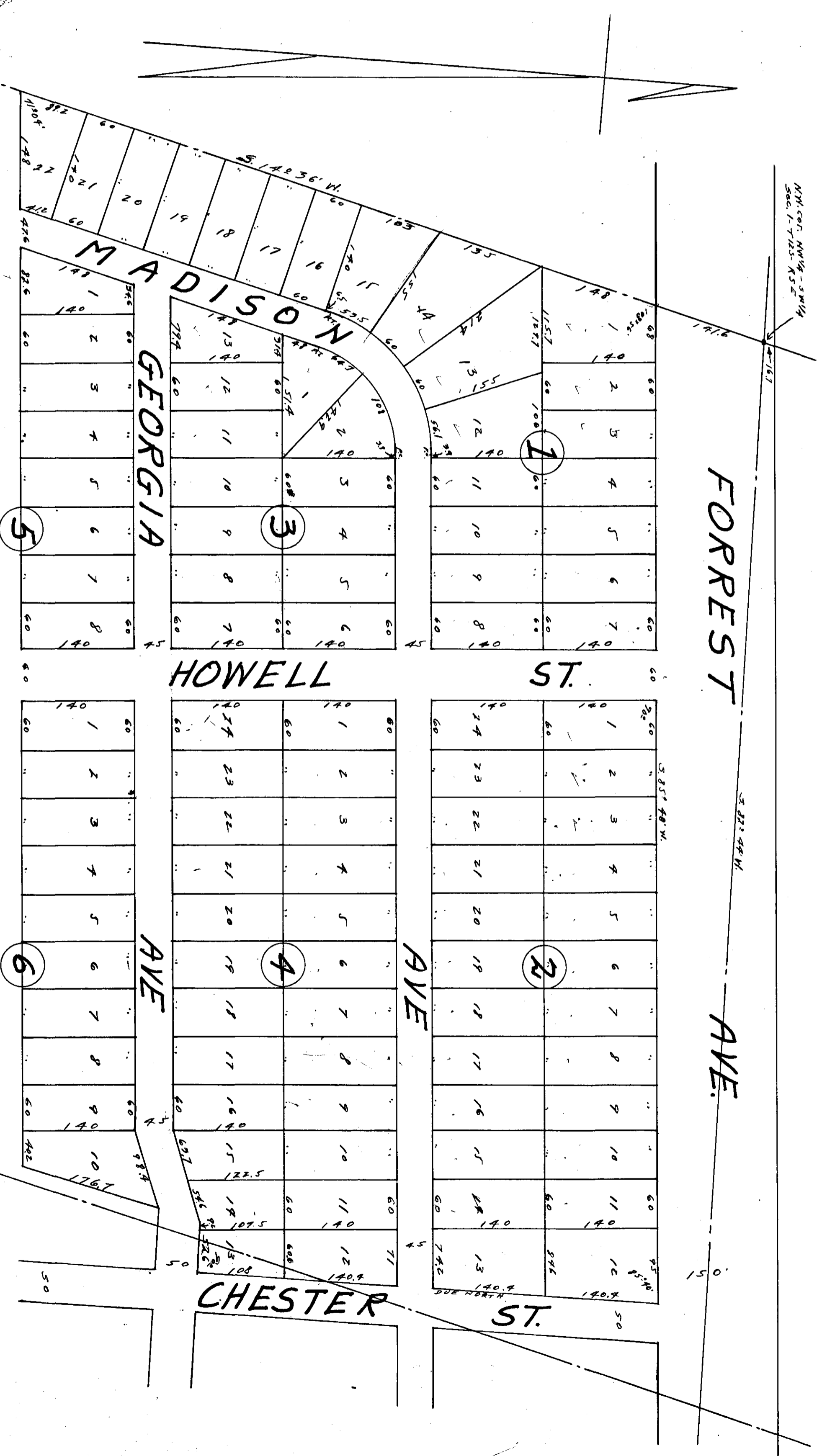


JAMES H. PRUETT
