

In the News

You know I have to brag on our tax prep program. This year volunteers prepared and filed 2,216 federal returns, which directly affected 3,087 people (including children and dependents). These families received a total of \$3,062,377 in refunds—that goes a long way in today's economy! But the thing I am most proud of is the group that we had this year. 38 people volunteered with this program and they all worked together to make sure that all of our tax locations were adequately covered; we had greeters at most of our locations which really helped reduce the stress levels of waiting clients on busy days, and it frees up preparers to concentrate on the people they are helping; plus everyone worked together to make this program a success!

Our Reading Buddies program will begin again this fall for next school year. If you are interested in helping elementary school children learn to read and comprehend better stay tuned for some of those recruitment and training events!
