

### In the News

Our tax volunteers have outdone themselves once again. We had a wonderful crew this year—38 volunteers! These people interviewed clients, prepared and filed 2,428 federal tax returns in 11 different locations all over Etowah County, in Cherokee County and Dekalb County. Counting all of the dependents on these returns, 3,298 people were helped this year and they received federal refunds of \$2,389,974!

There are 3 main focuses of this program: low-income, elderly, and rural citizens. BUT, we will help anyone who comes in regardless of age or income. The only thing that prevents us from preparing a tax return is if it is a complicated return (if that person owns a business, has rental income or a farm are some examples) that would require a paid professional.






