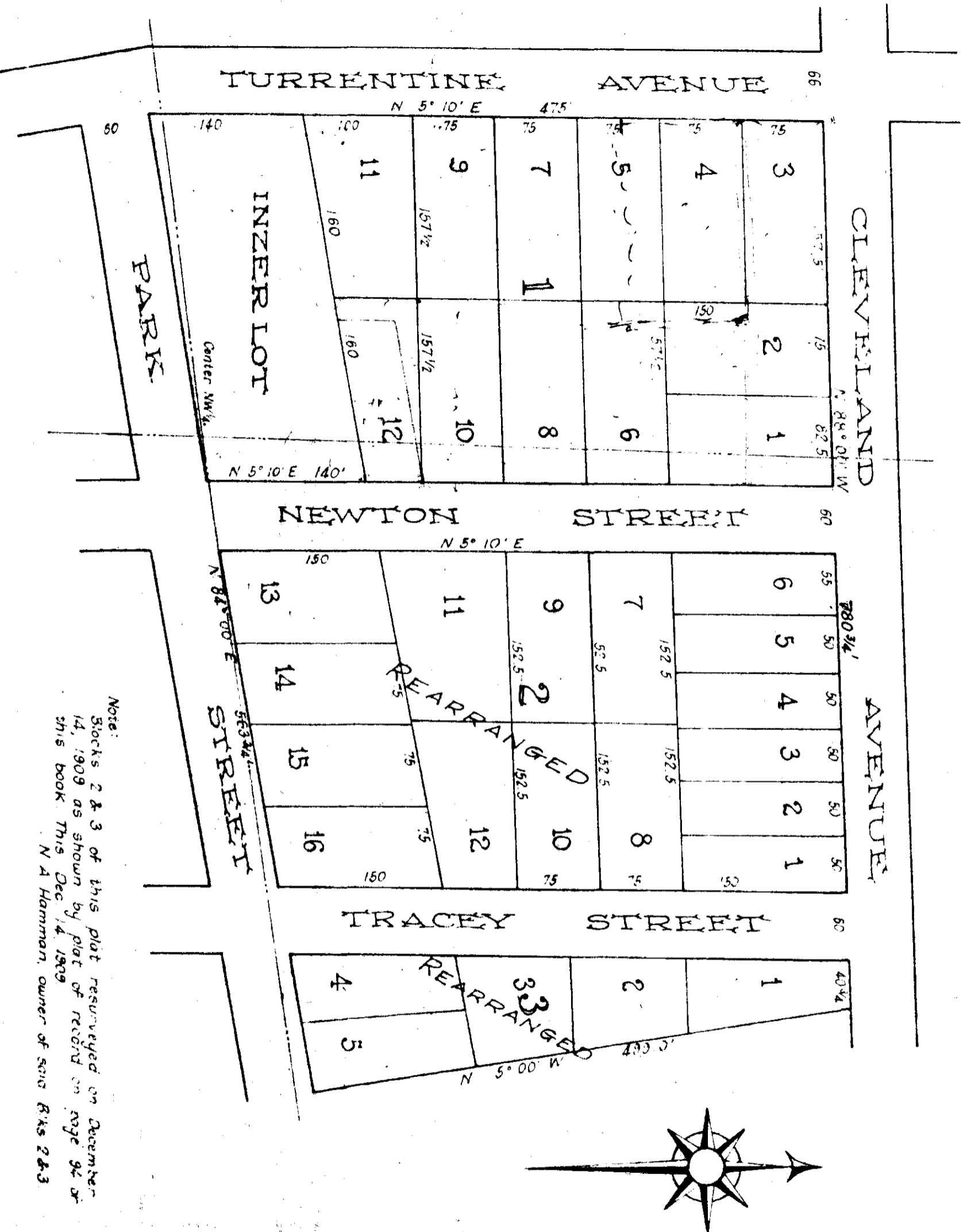


POLK ADDITION
