THE CENTER OF T & C RAILROAD CROSS-  
 ING IS ESTABLISHED AS BEING 1489.86'  
 FROM SOUTH SIDE OF PRESENT FURTH  
 AVE. NOW 15TH AVE. AND ALL MEASURE-  
 MENTS TO BE TAKEN THEREFROM.

THE CROSSING IN THE CENTER OF  
 T & C CROSSING IS 10.20' ABOVE DATUM  
 FOR LEVELS, A SUITABLE STONE WILL  
 BE PLACED NEAR CROSSING AND DATUM  
 ESTABLISHED.

THE RESERVOIR IS 218.4' ABOVE T & C  
 CROSSING.
