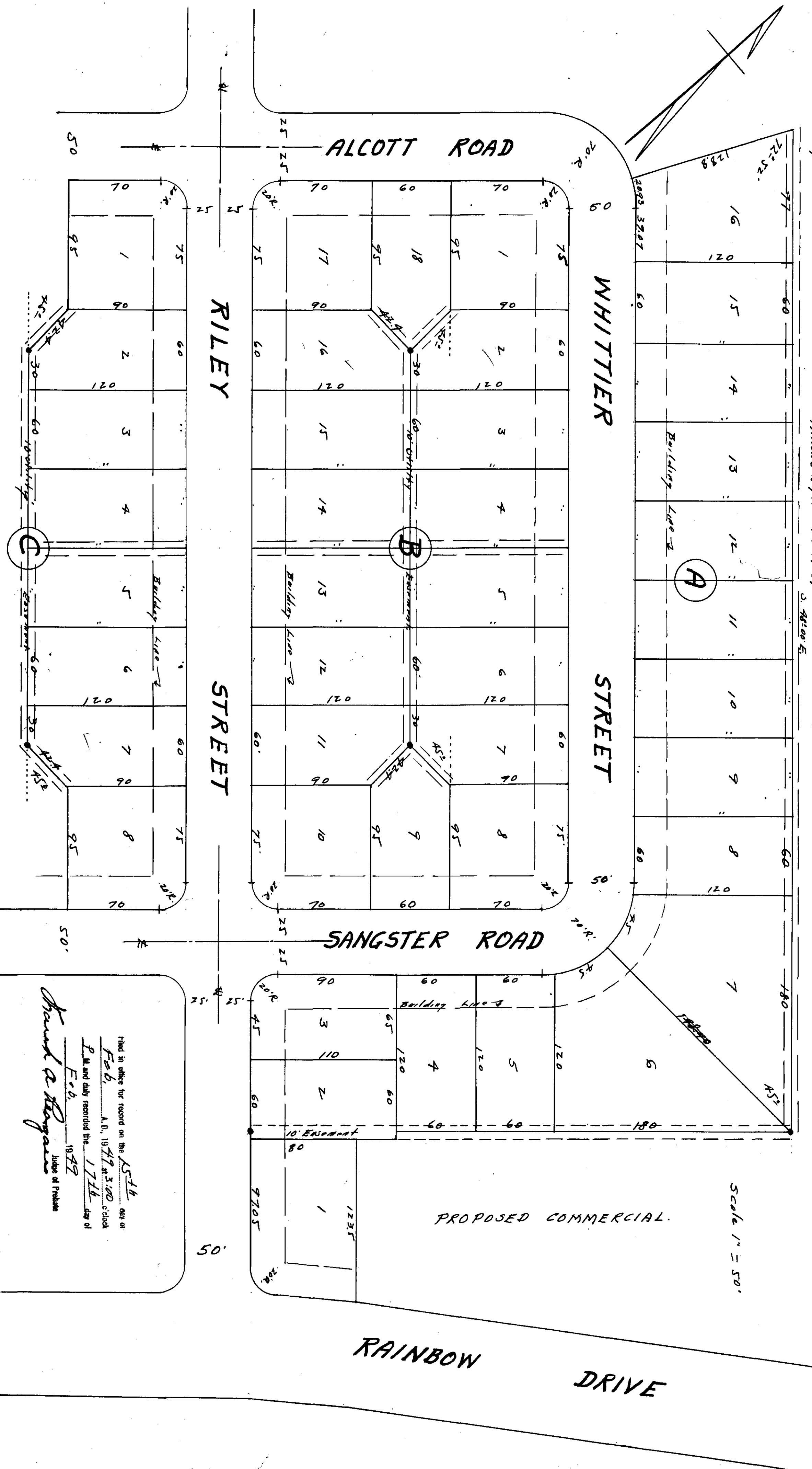


FIRST REARRANGEMENT OF ETOWAH PARK
